'A CALL TO PRAYER' FOR REFLECTION

'The Evangelisation of the world depends upon a revival of prayer. Prayer is the life blood of the people of God. The New Testament lays a greater stress on prayer than it does on the evangelisation of people. There is a deeper need to pray than there is even for people to be converted, and I don't say that lightly because there is a fierce need for conversion. But conversions won't happen unless we are praying and the Bible says that from beginning to end.

It is not because there is magic in prayer. The reason is the relationship with God, of which prayer is an expression. Of course prayer doesn't achieve anything in itself - it is God that achieves it, but through the relationship we have with him in prayer.'
